MORNING 18 JULY 1944

Woke to the sound of 6 ARTY REGTS + 14 SQUADRONS of LIREATORS BOMBARDING GERMAN POSITIONS IN THE WOODS TO OUR FRONT. (3 REGTS AGRA ATTACHED) INITIAL ATTACK PLAN HAS 152 BDE ON THE RIGHT AND 185 BDE ON LEFT CLEARING THE WOODS EITHER SIDE OF THE ROAD TO TROARN. TROARN IS THE OBJ OF 27 ARMA + 8 INF BDE (PLUS DIV RECCE) PASSING BETWEEN 185 + 152 BDE. 9 BDE IN RESERVE.

BRIEF CALL FROM 7 ARMA ASKING TO CROSS CORPS BOUNDARY FOR SUPPLIES OVERNIGHT - OUTRAGEOUS. CALL XXX CORPS TO COMPLAIN AT IMPERTINENCE

LIGHT RESISTANCE IN THE WOODS. 185 BDE CONT TO CLEAR 152 CONT CLEAR. ONE BN + CROCODILES PLUS 3 X FLD ARTY TO CLEAR WOODED T-JUNCTION (P69).

27 ARMA + 8 BDE BREAKING CLEAR OF START LINE AND READY TO BREAK OUT TO SE OF WOODS TOWARDS TROARN

MORNING 21 JULY 1944

IT HAS BEEN A GREAT HONOUR TO
COMMAND 3 DIVISION. MY STAFF AND
BRIGADE COMMANDERS ALL PERFORMED
EXCELLENT DUTIES AND WERE WELL SERVED
BY ALL OF THE MEN UNDER COMMAND

THE BREAKTHROUGH WAS EASIER THAN
ANTICIPATED AND THE ASSAULT ON TROARN
ON THE MORNING OF 19 JULY WAS A MODEL
OF COMBINED ARMS ASSAULT.

THE FOLLOW UP WAS BRIEFLY STALLED BY
A COUNTERATTACK FROM SS PZG + PZ BUT
TROARN WAS HELD AND AFTER REFITTING THE
TANKS A SUPERB COUNTERATTACK BY 27 ARMD
8 BDE AND 9 BDE SMASHED THE GERMAN
FORCES AND DROVE THEM BACK ACROSS THE
RIVER + CANAL ON THE AFTERNOON OF 20 JULY
